- Work with a variety of texts with different moral dilemmas

Science

Science offers the opportunity to ...

- Appreciate fair testing requires honest observation
- View the world in a more personal way
- Appreciate the diversity and order in our world
- Consider environmental problems (eg pollution, destruction of habitats)
- Promote the care of living things
- Consider ethical issues (eg factory farming)

Maths

Maths offers the opportunity to ...

- Value and appreciate the natural world and the mathematical structures found in it (eg: snowflakes, spider webs)
- Apply mathematical skills creatively in problem solving situations
- Deal with real life challenges creatively (eg How much water do we use? How much rubbish is generated?)
- Understand statistics and how they can be used to justify positions
- Promote co-operation and collaboration

RE

Religious Education offers the opportunity to ...

- Learn about the values held by different faiths
- Learn about different religious traditions
- Study the key teaching of different faiths (eg Jesus, Muhammad)
- Consider personal beliefs, values and attitudes and learn to communicate them

ICT

ICT offers the opportunity to ...

- Open up relationships with others near and far (online, email)
- Use the internet to explore ethical and social issues
- Explore and wonder at knowledge which is available
- Develop imagination and self-reflection
- Consider the potential unreliable nature of information and communication

Music

Music offers the opportunity to ...

- Be creative and cooperate with others
- Work independently or with others
- Appreciate music in a variety of contexts and how it can appeal to emotions (eg lifting spirits)
- Value music from a range of different cultures and traditions

- Consider resources needed and how to evaluate
- Learn about scientific, ethical, social and moral aspects of society
- Consider the influences on design and materials used
- Discuss the conflict between values (eg destruction of a forest for the need for furniture, destruction of a village for the need to build a dam)
- Express creativity and imagination
- Consider how different technology is found in different cultures

Drama Activities

Drama offers the opportunity to ...

- Explore and develop personal values - what matters to individuals
- Empathise with others and their experiences
- Develop an appreciation of rights and responsibilities
- Gain a deeper understanding of social issues
- Experience professional performances and personal emotional responses to them
- Be imaginative and use self expression

Art

Art offers the opportunity to ...

- Value creativity
- Make a personal response to the world through art
- Practically shape the environment
- Value the artistic contributions of different cultures
- Use art to raise awareness of important issues (eg designing and making posters, leaflets)
- Develop a personal view of what is aesthetically pleasing

History

History offers the opportunity to ...

- Appreciate how injustice has provoked people to bring about change and transformed lives
- Appreciate how values have changed over time and these changes have resulted in new laws, different attitudes and expectations (eg votes for women, abolition of slavery)

Geography

Geography offers the opportunity to ...

- Understand more about place in local and global communities
- Explore injustice and inequality (eg Fair Trade)
- Understand and consider sustainability (eg recycling)
- Consider the beauty and complexity of the natural world
- Develop empathy and positive attitudes towards others in our diverse world

PE

Physical Education offers the opportunity to ...

- Understand physical differences between people
- Understand how the body can be used creatively
- Consider fairness and the necessity for rules
- Appreciate the importance of team work and responsibility for others
- Learn to trust others
- Strive to achieve personal goals
- Appreciate gamesmanship and the positive and negative aspects of competitiveness

- Promote sense of self-worth, self identity and personal responsibility
