Session 1	<p>To explore how rhythm is used in a non-western musical tradition</p> <p>To learn about strong and weak beats in Indian talas</p> <p>To perform <i>Tintal</i> tala with increasing aural memory</p> <p>To compose and perform an Indian tala inspired rhythm in an ensemble with increasing accuracy</p>	<p>Lesson 3 of Indian Music Project</p> <p>Listen to the first minute of the link below (without showing the children the picture on screen).</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • www.youtube.com/watch?v=whLhMVLQsBA (from 23.43 Ravi Shankar) – use prompts from Lesson 3 planning <p>Explain that this music is an example of music from India.</p> <p>Look at powerpoint with pictures of the instruments playing in the clip above – identify the instruments heard.</p> <p>Learn a common type of <i>tala</i> called <i>Tintal</i>. It has sixteen beats and the strong and weak beats are marked with actions.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Use lesson plan prompt and grid. 	<p>I can listen carefully and respond to the music I hear</p> <p>I can develop my understanding of weak and strong beats</p> <p>I can count using my thinking voice and maintain a steady pulse</p> <p>I can perform in an ensemble with increasing accuracy and aural memory</p> <p>I can compose a tala</p>
