North Lincolnshire Children's and Young People's Lives Survey - Primary 2021

During the second half of the autumn term Year 5 & Year 6 pupils from all primary and Junior schools across North Lincolnshire are being given the opportunity to take part in a Lifestyle Survey. The last time we did this was in 2018.

This is an important survey created jointly by headteachers and North Lincolnshire Council. Its main aim is to help us improve services for children and young people in North Lincolnshire.

To do this the survey contains questions relating to pupils' feelings about school, healthy lifestyles, eating habits, physical activity, use of the internet, as well as other issues, some of which are related to personal safety.

The survey is undertaken on-line. We do not ask for pupil's names or date of birth and therefore the published results will not identify any individual.

The information will be sorted and analysed centrally by a public health team and then will be used to help improve services, focus resources and support the work of health improvement staff in North Lincolnshire.

Schools will receive a report on their overall results plus the combined results of all participating schools, which allows them to compare their results to the North Lincolnshire average. A report summarising the results for all North Lincolnshire will be published on-line.
